- Congratulations on a year of perseverance through Covid-19
- Registration is currently down: 1783 registered SCA Members, 2261 previous
- Funding depends on membership numbers. However, Sask Sport knows that sport participation is down throughout the province and will not base funding solely on membership numbers.
- SCA has launched a social media campaign to try to attract members.
- Encouraged members to join a committee (1 year commitment)
- Membership survey upcoming, The Board will be meeting with a facilitator to help them go through the data and use it to guide programming.
- Successful Coaches Conference in September 2021, including experts that were brought in and local presenters. 68 coaches attended. September 17-18, 2022 in Saskatoon is the next group.
- In October 2021, Coaches' clinics were provided virtually and in person.
- Coach Certification continued, and will continue. 157 Certified Coaches and CIT's in the province. Ashley Stevenson did a lot of work to get this database up and running.
- NCCP subsidized training continues this Spring. June 30th is the deadline for being reimbursed.
- Taping and Wrapping Clinics provided in June.
- Judges training took place in Regina, Saskatoon and virtually.
- Virtual Scoring was used this year. Thank you to Mishayla Kapell for setting this up.
- 24 Certified Judges this year.
- School Teams were offered a clinic in February to help them prepare for competition.
- Provincials was very well run – thank you to all the volunteers. March 18, 2023 will be provincials in Regina next year.
- Kim Fiissel worked with our athletes at Level Up Camps in May.
- High Performance Athlete Camp in July 2022
- Athlete Council offers ideas for athlete programs.
- Canadian Cheer Championships – May 2023
- ED had the opportunity to travel to Worlds to support our Saskatchewan Teams. The SCA would like to acknowledge the teams that competed. A special acknowledgement was made to Boss Athletics Performance Cheer who was selected as Team Canada, which is a first for Canada. Another special acknowledgement was to RCA Smoke who won Worlds.
